by John Bunyan (1628-1688)

Translated into over 100 languages, *The Pilgrim's Progress* is one of the most celebrated classics of literature. It is an allegorical novel, describing a Christian's journey through life to reach heaven. Part 1 was written by John Bunyan in 1679 while he was imprisoned for conducting unauthorised religious services; Part 2 was not written until 1684, and is not included in many versions of the text. This recording includes both parts, and inline scripture references.
